President Don Boulton

Don Boulton explained some of the problems he was having after the gate at the boat launch was installed. He asked that if you rent out your cottage out you should supply the renters with the key. He said he was running back and forth opening the gate. The gate was broken, twice in 2006. This year if anyone intentionally breaks the gate he will be calling the RCMP. He also said there is a public boat launch opening at "Wilmas Way". Also the new campgrounds are not part of the golf course and he was wondering if we are going to have people trying to use our beach.

The fishing derby was a success and cost the association nothing. One thousand dollars was given to the association for the improvements of the boat launch from proceeds of the derby.

The bump out at the boat launch was removed because more people are buying pontoon boats and the launch was not wide enough. It was also a hazard. Don read a letter from Hydro to the association that unauthorized work was done at the boat launch. A shoreline permit is needed for any work done on the shoreline. Don took full responsibility for the removal of the bump out. Alison Gregory brought it to Dons attention that he needs to do things by a vote. Don apologized for not doing things in the proper order and rule.

Concrete slabs and steel posts are being donated by Mike Dotoli and Robert Wiebe for the boat launch. Rob Steen reminded us that Hydro does not allow concrete in the water and that we must be careful with Hydro so that they do not revoke our privileges. We must first speak with Hydro, Fisheries and the RM before we do anything.

Dave Gregory reminded us that the executive oversees and approves everything we do in the community.

Website Discussion.

CapeCoppermine website was discussed at great length. Al Gavronski discussed what has been completed to date and what challenges he has had with securing a person to complete and maintain the site.

Lund will be donating a 14 foot boat and trailer; they were very impressed with last year's tournament. Mike thanked all dock owners for the use of their dock for the derby; He also said he would like to donate half of the proceeds to a sick child in Lac Du Bonnet. If anyone is concerned his name is on the permit. If any businesses would like to donate prizes they are welcome to call Mike. Someone also suggested that if you would like your boat checked out the Office of Boating Safety would come out and do it. The boat launch will be in use by the derby for three hours before and after the derby 8:00 am - 4:00 pm.

Don thanked Mike and assured us that all revenues go as promised to upgrade the boat launch.

Don received Dave Gregory resignation as past president and he apologized if he did anything, but he also thanked him for all his time and the hours he had put in as president.
